NEW INFORMATION

With safety as the first consideration, every effort will be made for crews to finish their race, even if they receive assistance after capsizing.

For time trial and sprint racing, if there is an equipment failure such that a crew cannot finish their race, they will be relegated as per the exception granted through the Sanction process (see Bulletin 2).

SAFE SPORT REQUIREMENTS

Athletes, Coaches, and Umpires attending the NRC Regatta are required to complete a consent form with the Office of the Sport Integrity Commissioner of Abuse Free Sport by Tuesday October, 8th, 2024.

Anyone under the age of 19 requires a parent/guardian to sign on their behalf. The parent/guardian similarly must be 19 or over.

Participants including coaches, athletes, umpires who signed the new <u>Abuse Free Sport Consent Form</u> distributed by RCA in May 2024, do not need to sign again.

There is a module that you must complete before you can sign. The consent form is contained within the module. The modules contain some helpful explanations for some of the legalese that is included in the consent form.

It may take you between 15-30 minutes to complete this depending on how often you pause or choose to do the additional reading/listening that is available in the module.

ID REQUIREMENTS

Please note that photo ID is mandatory for athlete weigh-ins and dock access during racing. Acceptable ID will be any **government issued** document with a photo and date of birth - This can be a passport, driver's licence, provincial ID card, or provincial health card (provided it has a picture). Additional details on Acceptable ID may be found in Bulletin 2.

Photos of ID on electronic devices will *not be* accepted.

BOAT DRIVERS DURING TRAINING PERIODS

Practice times will be subject to availability of coaches to drive safety boats. Safety boat drivers must be provided by the club and have a valid Pleasure Craft Operators License, as shown at the time of signing up. Safety boat drivers and crews must sign in at the Regatta Office before launching for practice.

Any athletes or crews practicing without a designated safety boat will be issued a yellow card when they check into Control Commission for their first event.

The course will only be open for practice if weather and water conditions permit, at the discretion of the Regatta Chair and Chief Umpire.
