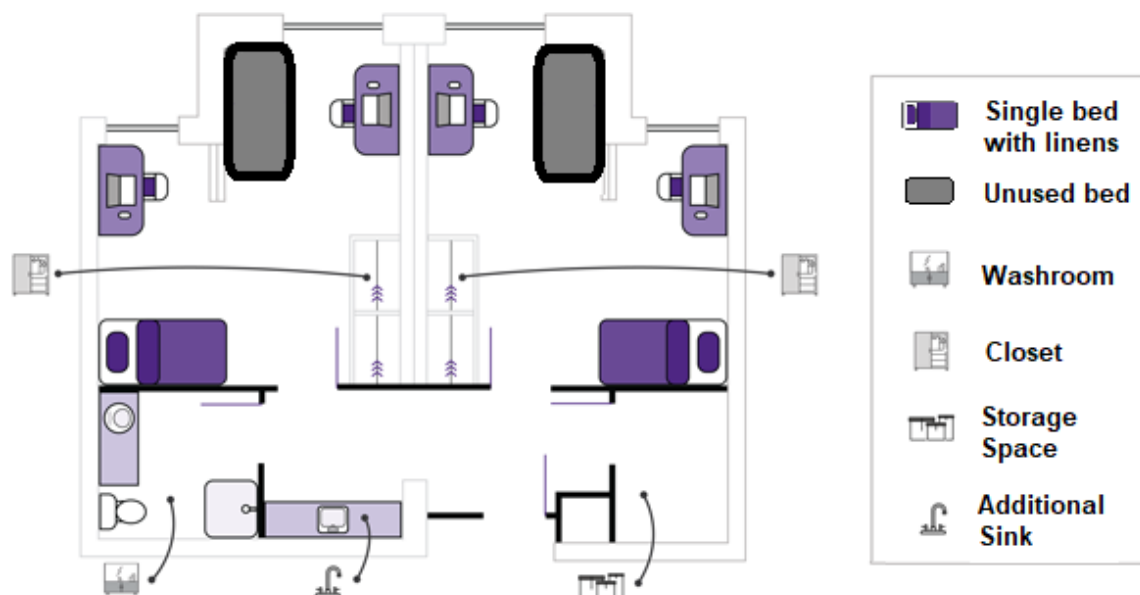

ACCOMMODATIONS

Each Suite-Style apartment offers semi-private shared accommodations featuring a single, lockable bedroom and a shared washroom (between 2 people). Each bedroom is equipped with a single bed, blanket, bed linens, pillow, bath towels, facecloth, washing soap and a drinking cup. Each unit is equipped with its own climate controlled heat/air conditioning unit.

Suggested items to bring; hair dryer, shampoo.

MEALS

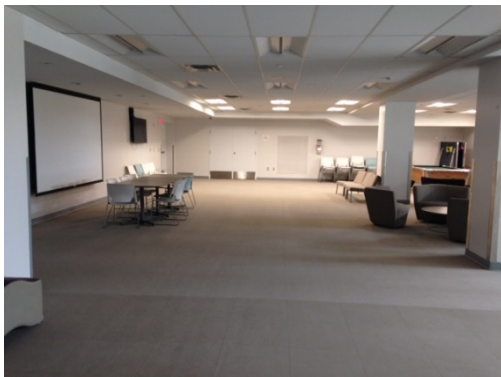

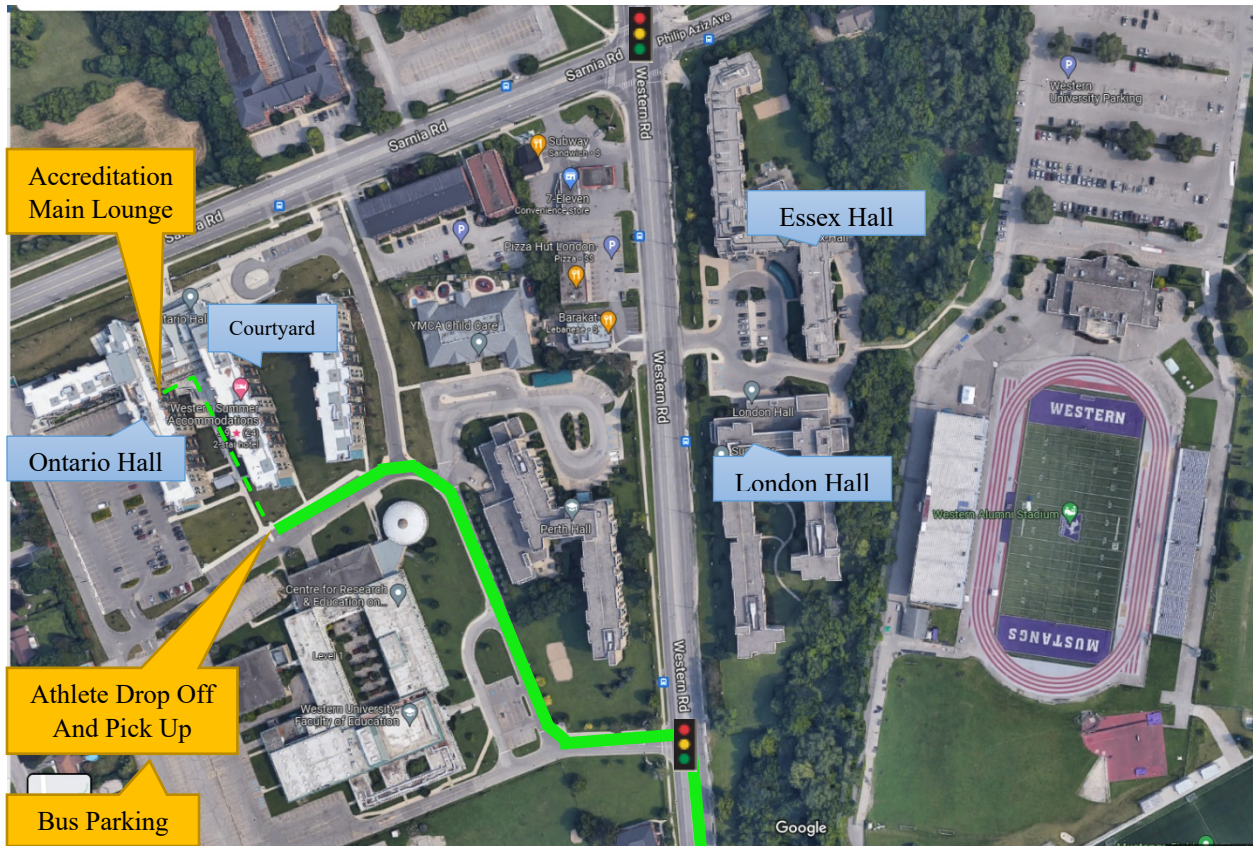


ONTARIO HALL FLOORS

ATHLETE DROP OFF AND PICK UP

TRANSPORTATION

The LOC is requesting feedback on the level of transportation requested for athletes and coaches. Since teams will be traveling from Royal Canadian Henley, we would like to understand the extent to which group transportation is required. Group transportation can be provided from residence to the Doug Wells Training Centre, and from residence to the **London International Airport YXU** if this is desired. The extent of transportation assistance will be subject to change based on funding and athlete participation.

PAYMENT AND SCHEDULE

At this time, we are still anticipating a cost approximately 1250 CDN per athlete. The priority of the LOC remains to make this event financially reasonable for all participants. However, we are monitoring the recent increase in the cost of fuel and its effects particularly on transportation. It is our hopes that we can manage this internally. EQUIPMENT

Boats rented will come from local partners where possible and prices will be assigned by those local partners and NOT the LOC. The request deadline for equipment is **JUNE 1st, 2025**. Oars can also be provided with very limited selection of design and length. These oars cannot be painted or decaled and the owners will assign the price. This is not first come-first serve. It is our goal is to get as many teams and athletes competing as possible and we will assist in this process as much as we can where needed across PSOs and within reason.
